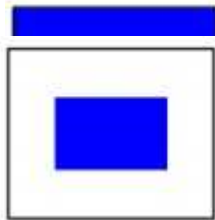

Sailing Instructions

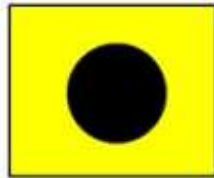
1. This race, the "Canadian Coast Guard College Cup" (*the race*) will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
2. There will be only once class, and one race. Therefore there is only one race time, scheduled for 12:00(L). The following page of this document has a table and graphics that will describe the starting sequence.
3. Courses and race marks will be determine prior to the skipper's meeting (10:00(L)) and will be clearly detailed therein. If a change of course is required To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will lay a new mark (or move the finishing line) and remove the original mark as soon as practicable. The appropriate signal flags will be displayed. These are also detailed on the following page.
4. The starting line and finish line will be between the race commette boat and a yellow (orange) tetrahydran.
5. *The race* will be called 90 minutes after the first boat finishes *the race*.
6. The PHRF handicap rating system will be used to produce an adjusted time for every boat in *the race*.
7. The boat with the lowest adjusted time will win first place in *the race*, the second lowest adjusted time will win second place in *the race*, and the third lowest adjusted time will win third place in *the race*.

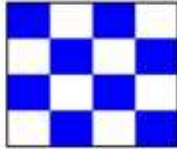

Starting	Class flag removed; 1 sound	0



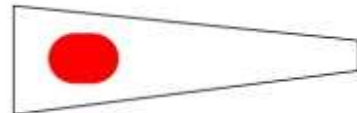
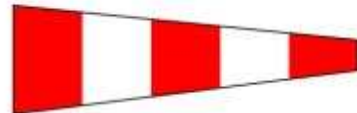

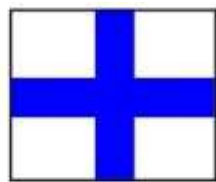
Rule 30.1 is in effect



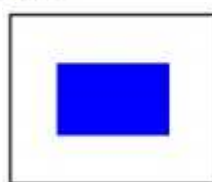
All races are abandoned, no more racing today



AP 1, the race will be postponed for one hour



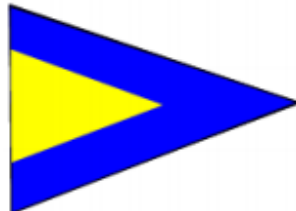
Individual recall
