Other APPENDIX A

1. Storage area **not** cleaned up in 36 hours \$50.00
2. All Membership Dues to be paid in full by 31 January
3. Boats must have \$2,000,000.00 third party liability insurance
4. 48 hours notice to be provided to lift coordinator for launch / haul-out
5. Mast crane area 45 minutes maximum in duration
6. Launch / haul-out requires Min 3 people, not including lift operator / spotter
7. Winter storage applies to vessels on property after September 30
8. NYC boating season to run from May 15st – October 15 of each year
9. Bottom cleaning will take place at the storage area of the vessel and not at lift.
10. Only members who have booked a time for lift with the wharves and slipways chair, shall be exempt from berthing / wharfage fees, in the event of lift repairs, to a maximum of five days.
11. The chair of wharves and slipways or his/her representative will post within the NYC when the lift is out of service.
12. Members who own boats using the facilities will provide a valid insurance card prior to or at time of lift ticket purchase.
13. Boat owners who do not launch their boat will be contacted by the Wharf and Slipway Chair to insure insurance compliance.
14. Operator's fee shall be paid at the time of lift ticket purchase at the bar.

Other Business:

APPENDIX B

- 1 Persons shall pay fee prior to use of ramp.
- 2 Persons including members / non-members shall leave their driver license with the bar when receiving the key for ramp.
- 3 Commercial vendors using the slipway for hire shall pay a commercial rate for each use.
- 4 A berth waiting list will be advertised and kept up to date by Chair of wharf.
- 5 Members are to maintain their respective cradles and or jacks in a safe manner. Boats not safely supported will be asked to remedy immediately or be refused service from the NYC.

Definition

- 1 Clean up means any debris from boat maintenance or reconstruction.
- 2 Unless in an emergency boat owners will provide at least 48 hour notice prior to lift date.
- 3 Boat owners using the mast lift will be mindful of others waiting for the same service.
- 4 If a boat owner cannot have the requested persons available he/she will make arrangements prior to the lift with the lift operator.
- 5 Summer storage is from June 1 and ends on October 1 of each year.
- 6 The start of season is weather dependent. All efforts will be made to have the lift and berths in place as soon as practical. The travel lift will be out of service for the season after October 31 or earlier (weather dependent).
- 7 In the event of a lift break down only boat owners who previously provided 48 hour notice will be given consideration for berthing fees exception, to a max of five days.
- 8 Notification for lift issues will be found on the bulletin board as well as staff notification.
- 9 Members who do not provide insurance coverage will be denied lift access.
- 10 The Chair of Wharves and slipway will contact boat owners who do not launch for insurance compliance. Boat owners who fail to produce a valid insurance card may be denied use of the yacht club facilities and or asked to remove their boat from NYC property.
- 11 **Commercial Rate:** Commercial rate applies only to the slipway. Vendors using the travel lift will not be charged any addition fees.
- 12 **Berthing List:** A list will be maintained for members wishing to purchase a berth. A second list will be kept for those looking to rent.
- 13 **NS Yacht Club:** Any member in good standing, current year, of another Nova Scotia Yacht Club will be offered the rate of \$10.00 per day up to 35 ft.
